

Pupil Premium Spend at Queen's Park CE/URC Primary School

At Queen's Park CE/URC Primary School, around 40% of our children are in receipt of pupil premium funding. It is important that you as parent/carers know what this money is spent on to support your children academically, socially and emotionally but also how it is used to prepare them to succeed in adult life!

Pupil Premium: Our Intent



All children should receive a high-quality education whilst at our school, regardless of background. Our Crown Curriculum is carefully designed to ensure this happens.

All children should receive quality first teaching every day in our classrooms from teachers who really care about their success.



Where children find something a little tricky, they will be supported in an individualised intervention to get them back on track as quickly as possible!

We aim for all children to leave our school with a love of reading and be able to read fluently as this is such an important life skill.



We believe it is really important to be in school every day. Our attendance team will support any children or families to make sure that minimal learning time is lost.

Learning isn't just about classroom fun at our school. All children will have access to trips, visitors and extra curricular activities during their time at Queen's Park.

All children will be supported emotionally, and their wellbeing will be monitored throughout their time at our school. For children we need some extra support, our pastoral team will work closely with children and families to ensure they get all the help they need.



Take a look at just some of the things our Pupil Premium money is spent on...



We make sure that every class has at least one teaching assistant allocated to them to provide in class support and targeted intervention.



In some classes, we have three teachers to allow us to teach smaller classes to ensure that all the children get lots of teacher time!



We employ our own speech and language therapist for one day per week to deliver speech therapy to targeted children across the school.




We also employ a school counsellor for one day per week to support our children across the school.



We purchase subscriptions for lots of online programmes to support our children's learning, for example Reading Plus, Times Tables Rockstars and Nessy (to name just a few).



We have Mrs Leadbetter and Mrs Hughes as our pastoral team to support children pastorally. Mrs Hughes runs our nurture groups. They also work really closely with our families too.



We run a Breakfast Club and employ extra staff so that we can listen to our children read at the same time as giving them breakfast.



We invite special guests into school and go on trips to give our children wider experiences. These are always our favourite days at Queen's Park!
