

Queen's Park CE/URC Primary school is incredibly proud of its dual denominational heritage.

We have three churches that we work alongside: St Luke's COE, Newtown URC and Ormskirk Street URC. All of our churches work in a meaningful, reciprocal and vision-driven partnership with each other and offer fantastic support. Each of our three churches has worships with our whole school community regularly:





St Lukes CE Eccleston - Rev Gareth or members of the Ministry Team visits school monthly to lead worship. We have one foundation governor from St Lukes, Kate, she is committed to our school.

Ormskirk Street URC - Our 'Worship Warriors' come from Ormskirk Street to lead worship every month along with Rev Cath. We have three governors that are from Ormskirk Street: Rev. Cath, Ann and Margret.










Newtown URC - Rev Diane comes to deliver worship at our school half termly - the children really enjoy listening to her stories.

Our churches also offer a range of services and experience events throughout the year to our children. This partnership ensures that our pupils have a wider and richer range of opportunities and that all that elements of SMSC are enhanced. Each year our three churches join with the headteacher and Religious Education/Collective Worship lead, to plan events and visits for the next year which are outlined below.
