

MFL Coaching model 2022-2023

Intent

<u>Context:</u>

We have two language specialists in school who are fluent French speakers: Miss Jones and Mrs Taylor. Our language teachers teach French across school from EYFS - Year 6. We operate this model to give the children the best possible specialist language provision.

In order to strengthen the languages team, a coaching model is in place to support the development of languages at Queen's Park.

The coaching model is for both specialists to observe one another's teaching, to meet regularly to monitor their subject and to analyse data in MFL. The strengths and areas for development are identified and a plan is in place to enhance future teaching and learning, based on the needs of our children.
